Application Checklist

Step 1 -	- Application – All Grades
	Complete Application Form online - Grades Kindergarten Prep – Eighth
	Pay the non-refundable Application Fee – Grades Kindergarten Prep – Eighth
	Kindergarten Prep (must be 4 years old by September 1 st of school year) must submit full payment of required non-refundable <i>Enrollment Fees</i> and copies of <i>Required Application Documents</i> (see below) <u>now</u> . Kindergarten Prep automatically accepted for admission.
	Kindergarten (must be 5 years old by September 1 st of school year) must submit a partial payment of enrollment fees now and, if student is accepted, payment will be applied toward required non-refundable <i>Enrollment Fees</i> . Kindergarten will be notified of acceptance decision after the admission entrance assessment.
Step 2 -	- Admission Entrance Assessment- Grades Kindergarten - Eighth
Kinderg	arten admission entrance assessments take place in late spring.
	Make appointment for admission entrance assessment— A member of the admissions team will contact you. Current PCPS students need not make an appointment as they are assessed during one of their school days.
Step 3 -	- Required Application Documents – All Grades

	Grades First - Eighth Submit payment of required non-refundable Enrollment Fees online for each student and turn in required Enrollment Documents (see Step 6) (payment for siblings may be combined on 1 check)
